Release notes 1.95 2018-08-23

This version of the Tobii Pro Glasses Controller contains new Firmware for the Tobii Pro Glasses 2.

Controller updates:

- End User License Agreement (EULA) is updated. Accept the terms in the EULA to continue using the Controller software.
- Showing the Eye images video in Live view is now only available with the bundled version of the firmware (1.25.3).
- Saving Eye images video is now protected with a password. Contact Tobii to get the password.

Firmware updates:

- Bug fix for audio disappearing during replay.
- Tobii Pro Lab, version 1.61 and earlier are not compatible with this firmware.

Important Notices:

1. This update includes a Firmware for your Tobii Pro Glasses 2 Recording Unit that will increase the eye tracking sampling rate from 30 Hz to 50 Hz for all new recordings made after the update. Don't perform the upgrade now If you are currently using the Glasses 2 for data collection or if you are using the Tobii Glasses 2 for a longitudinal or benchmarking study.
2. Tobii Pro Glasses 2 recordings in 50 Hz can only be imported and analyzed in Tobii Glasses Analysis Software version 1.12 or later. Please make sure you have the latest version of the software before importing any new recordings made after the firmware upgrade.

Controller updates:

- Includes new Firmware that enables 50 Hz eye tracking as well as the Gyro and Accelerometer sensors in your Tobii Glasses.
- The live view now indicates where the calibration marker is found during calibration (requires firmware update).
- Fixes a problem that occurred when connected to the Recording Unit through cable and WiFi simultaneously.
- Stability Improvements

Major changes:

- Gaze data is now produced in 50 Hz.
- Data from the MEMS sensors (Gyro & Accelerometer) are now available in the Recordings.
- Improved gaze detection rate.

Minor changes:

- Recorded sound is no longer distorted at loud volumes.
- Connecting to glasses with WLAN now goes faster (less time to wait until Glasses become available in list of available networks).
- Calibration marker position is shown in live view during calibration.
- The upgrade procedure no longer requires you to manually start the Recording Unit once it is finished upgrading.
- Stability improvements.

Known issues:

- The name of the Glasses (changeable from Controller) will be reset to default value (Recording unit's serial number) after the upgrade. You can give it a new name after the upgrade.
- Shutdown time of Glasses is longer than for previous versions. Please be patient and wait for the solid yellow lights to go out before removing batteries!

- Fixed a problem causing Replay to freeze after seeking
